Title I Parent Involvement

The South Windsor Board of Education believes that positive parental involvement is essential to student achievement, and thus encourages such involvement in school educational planning and operations. Parental involvement may take place either in the classroom or during extra-curricular activities. However, the Board also encourages parental involvement at home (e.g., planned home reading time, informal learning activities, and/or homework "contracts" between parents and children.)

To assure compliance with federal Title I guidelines, the South Windsor Board of Education further directs the administration to implement programs, activities and procedures to achieve parental involvement in planning, designing and implementing such programs.

All such programs are intended to strengthen the relationship between home and school.
